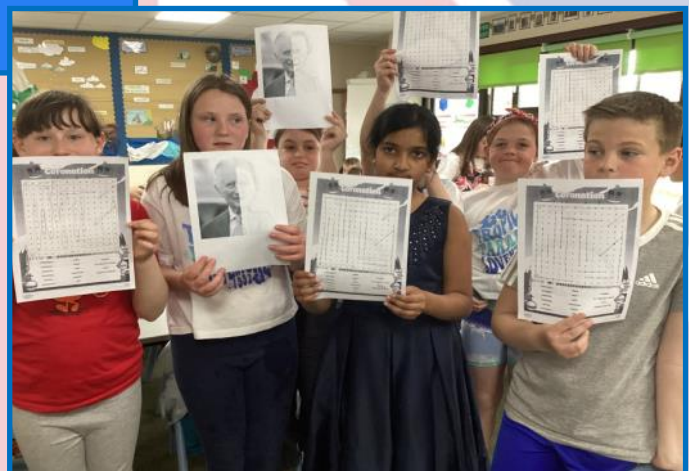
The Buttercups had lots of fun celebrating the Kings Coronation with their friends from Reception at the 'Royal Ball in the Hall'.

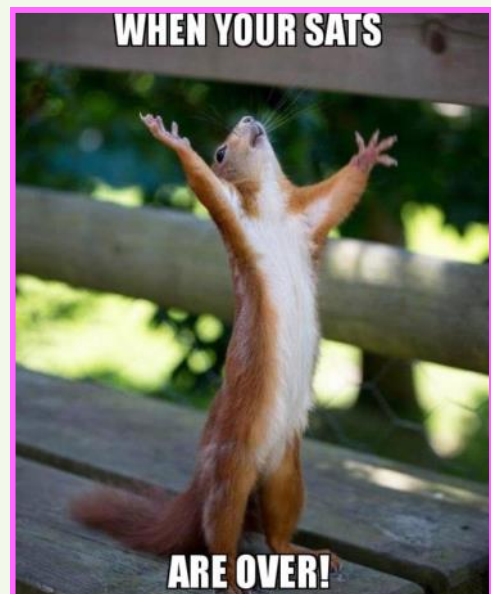

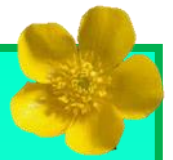
