
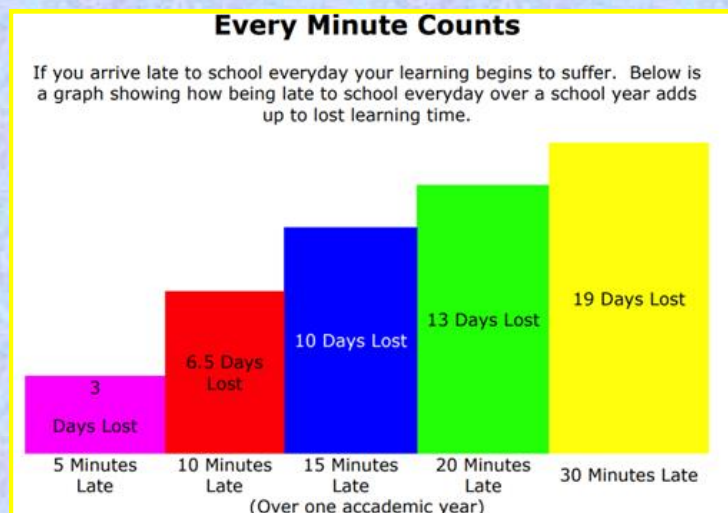


Shining A Light on Attendance

Lateness



Morning registration takes place at the start of Lesson 1 at **8.55am**. **Registers close at 9.00am**. Pupils are expected to be on site by **8.45am** to avoid them being late for registration. Pupils who arrive after 8.55am must sign in at the school office and will be asked about their reason for their late arrival. Please see the chart below that shows you how being late each day amounts to many days of missed learning, that can have a detrimental effect to a child's education. Please do speak to your child's Class Teacher if you are experiencing any difficulties in getting your child to school on time or contact the school office who can arrange for a member our Pastoral Support Team to contact you so that you and your child are fully supported.



Term Time Absence

Government guidelines prevent headteachers from granting any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. A family holiday does not fall into the category of 'exceptional circumstances' such holidays will be counted as an unauthorised absence. If you are planning to take your child out of school you must fill in a Term Time Absence form. Please contact the school office who will provide you with this form. Each case will be considered individually and the decision communicated to the parents/carers. When a pupil has a minimum of 10 school sessions recorded as unauthorised in a 6 school week period; (a school day is two sessions morning and afternoon), as per government guidelines cases will be referred to the Local Authority for the issuing of a Penalty Notice (fine). Details of the fine amount and what happens next is explained in the TTA form that you will be issued when requesting the absence. Any questions please contact the school office in the first instance.

In cases where a child has had 2 periods of unauthorised leave for which the parent has been issued with a PN, on the third occasion no PN will be issued and that parent will be prosecuted under S444(1).
